Section 1.1: Safety

The PolarCool 90-Gallon Water Cart, used with your PolarCool fan, provides enough extra water for a full day of operation. The design uses gravity to supply your PolarCool fan as water evaporates throughout the day. The addition of quick connects on the fill hose and your PolarCool fan makes for quick and easy detachment if refilling the cart requires moving it to a fill station.

Section 1.4 Limited Warranty

For three years from the date of invoice, PolarCool, a division of HH Technologies, Inc., warrants the motor and any electrical components of the PolarCool Evaporative Cooling System ("the Product") that are found, upon examination by factory-authorized personnel, to be defective in material and/or workmanship.

PolarCool also warrants the metal housing of the Product for the full lifetime of the Product to the extent it is found, upon examination by factory-authorized personnel, to be defective in material and/or workmanship. The Lifetime Warranty on the Product housing does not cover ordinary wear and tear.

If any of the original component parts, including the Product housing, exhibit any defect(s) covered by this Limited Warranty within the applicable time periods defined above, the same may be repaired or replaced at PolarCool's discretion.

This Limited Warranty excludes any labor, equipment, transportation, and/or service expenses that may be required to remedy the warranted defect(s); all such charges must be funded by the purchaser. Neither the Product nor any of its component parts are to be returned for repair or replacement until they have been inspected and/or a Return Goods Authorization (RGA) number has been issued.

Complaints are to be directed first to the authorized distributor who sold the Product. If satisfaction is not obtained and/or the distributor cannot be contacted, complete the warranty form at *polarcool.net/polarcool-return-policy/*.

This Limited Warranty is void if (a) the Product and/or any of its component parts are found to have been misused, abused, or otherwise tampered with by unqualified personnel; (b) any of the Product's component parts have been replaced by anything other than authorized PolarCool replacement parts; (c) the Product has been modified in any way other than officially sanctioned upgrades made by qualified personnel using authorized PolarCool accessories; (d) the Product has not been appropriately registered by its original purchaser; and/or (e) the customer cannot provide proof of purchase indicating them to be the Product's original owner.

This Limited Warranty is made solely to the original purchaser of the Product. It cannot be transferred.

This Limited Warranty is in lieu of any and all other representations and/or warranties, expressed or implied, including any implied warranty of merchantability and/or fitness for a particular purpose. 

Section 2: Assembly

Section 2.1: Step 1


Insert pictured $5/16 \times 18 \times 3/4$ " carriage bolts and secure in place with 5/16" nylon lock nuts. **Do not completely tighten the nylon lock nuts until the completion of step 2.**



Ensure that when assembling these parts, the three inner holes on part "B" face the opposite direction of the tongue on part "P". Also ensure that the tongue on part "N" faces the opposite direction of the flange on part "K".

Section 2.1.1: Required Fasteners

Needed: **(8)** 5/16 x 18 x 3/4" carriage bolts | **(8)** 5/16" nylon lock nuts



Section 2.2: Step 2


Install label 4501-0217 on each gusset "G" before assembly.

Insert pictured $5/16 \times 18 \times 3/4$ " carriage bolts and secure in place with 5/16" nylon lock nuts. **Do not completely tighten the nylon lock nuts until all bolts are in place.**

Insert pictured 5/16" x 21/4" cap screws and secure in place with 5/16" nylon lock nuts. **Do not completely tighten the nylon lock nuts until both cap screws are in place.**

Section 2.2.1: Required Fasteners

Needed: **(18)** 5/16 x 18 x 3/4" carriage bolts | **(20)** 5/16" nylon lock nuts | **(2)** 5/16" x 2 1/4" cap screws




Section 2.3: Step 3

Insert pictured $5/16 \times 18 \times 3/4$ " carriage bolts and secure in place with 5/16" nylon lock nuts. **Do not completely tighten the nylon lock nuts until all bolts are in place.**

Section 2.3.1: Required Fasteners

Needed: **(8)** 5/16 x 18 x 3/4" carriage bolts | **(8)** 5/16" nylon lock nuts




Section 2.4: Step 4

Insert pictured $5/16 \times 18 \times 3/4$ " carriage bolts and secure in place with 5/16" nylon lock nuts. **Do not completely tighten the nylon lock nuts until all bolts are in place.**

Section 2.4.1: Required Fasteners

Needed: **(24)** 5/16 x 18 x 3/4" carriage bolts | **(24)** 5/16" nylon lock nuts




Section 2.5: Step 5

Insert pictured 3/8 x 1" carriage bolts and secure in place with 3/8" nylon lock nuts and 3/8" flat washers. **Do not completely tighten the nylon lock nuts until all bolts and washers are in place.**

Section 2.5.1: Required Fasteners

Needed: **(16)** 3/8 x 1" carriage bolts | **(16)** 3/8" nylon lock nuts | **(16)** 3/8" flat washers




Section 2.6: Step 6

Insert pictured $1/4 \times 5/8$ " self-clinching bolts and secure in place with 1/4-20 lock nuts. **Do not completely tighten the lock nuts until all bolts are in place.**

Insert and tighten pictured #10 x 1" self-clinching bolt and #10-24 lock nut.

Section 2.6.1: Required Fasteners

Needed: **(5)** 1/4 x 5/8" self-clinching bolts | **(5)** 1/4-20 lock nuts | **(1)** #10 x 1" self-clinching bolt | **(1)** #10-24 lock nut




Section 2.7: Step 7

Insert pictured $5/16 \times 18 \times 3/4$ " carriage bolts and secure in place with 5/16" nylon lock nuts. **Do not completely tighten the nylon lock nuts until all bolts are in place.**

Section 2.7.1: Required Fasteners

Needed: **(4)** 5/16 x 18 x 3/4" carriage bolts | **(4)** 5/16" nylon lock nuts




Section 2.8: Step 8

Insert pictured $5/16 \times 18 \times 3/4$ " carriage bolts and secure in place with 5/16" nylon lock nuts. **Do not completely tighten the nylon lock nuts until all bolts are in place.**

Attach the handle grips.

Section 2.8.1: Required Fasteners

Needed: **(2)** 5/16 x 18 x 3/4" carriage bolts | **(2)** 5/16" nylon lock nuts




Section 2.9: Step 9

Insert pictured 3/8" x 2 3/4" cap screw and secure in place with 3/8" nylon lock nut and delrin washers. **Do not completely tighten the nylon lock nut until the cap screw and washers are in place.**

Section 2.9.1: Required Fasteners

Needed: (1) 3/8" x 2 3/4" cap screw | (1) 3/8" nylon lock nut | (2) delrin washers




Section 2.10: Step 10

Install the water bladder.

NOTICE


Ensure the bladder is lying flat in the bottom of the pan and there is no pressure on the valve coming out the side before filling the unit with water.



Section 2.11: Step 11

Fill the water bladder:

- 1. Ensure the cap is installed.
- 2. Connect the water hose to the quick connect fitting on the bladder valve.
- 3. Turn the valve to open.
- 4. Turn the water supply on to fill the bladder.
- 5. Ensure not to overfill the bladder. It may be required to slightly loosen the cap on top to allow air to escape when filling.



Section 2.12: Step 12

Attaching to Unit:

Connect the unused end of the hose to the female swivel on the PolarCool Pro.
